PLEASE **Por favor** (pohr- fah-VOHR)  
THANK YOU **Muchas gracias** (MOO-chas GRAH-see-ahs)  
YOU'RE WELCOME **De Nada** (deh NAH-dah)

GOOD MORNING **Buenos dias** (BWEH-nos DEE-as)  
GOOD AFTERNOON **Buenas tardes** (BWEH-nahs TARD-ehs)  
GOOD NIGHT **Buenas noches** (BWEH-nahs NOH-chehs)

HELLO **Hola** (OH-la)  
GOODBYE **Adios** (ah-dee-OHS)

WHERE **Donde** (DOHN-deh)  
WHEN **Cuando?** (KWAHN-doh)

WHAT IS YOUR NAME? **Como te llamas? (informal) Como se llama usted? (polite)**  
MY NAME IS **xxxx Me llamo xxxxx**  
HOW DO YOU DO? **Como le va?** (KOH-moh -leh- VAH)  
HOW'S IT GOING? **(informal) Que tal?** (KEH Tal)  
HOW ARE YOU? **Como esta usted?** (KOH-moh ehs-TAH oos-TEHD)  
VERY WELL THANK YOU **Muy bien, gracias** (moeee bee-EHN GRAH-see-as)

I DON'T KNOW. **No se.** (Noh seh)  
I DON'T UNDERSTAND. **No entiendo.** (Noh ehn-TEE-ehn-doh)  
HOW DO YOU SAY IT IN SPANISH? **Como se dice en espanol?** (Koh-moh seh DEE-sehh ehn es-pah-nyol)  
SPEAK SLOWLY PLEASE. **Hable despacio, por favor.** (AH-bleh dehs-PAH-see-oh)  
I AM VERY HOT **Tengo mucho calor** (TEHN-goh muh-choh kah-lohr)  
I AM COLD **Tengo frio** (TEHN-goh FREE-oh)  
I'M THIRSTY **Tengo sed** (TEHN-goh said)  
I'M HUNGRY **Tengo Hambre**
